Keith Curry Lance, Ph.D., is the Director of the Library Research Service of the Colorado State Library and the University of Denver. He also teaches for the University of Denver Library and Information Science Program, and consults with the RSL Research Group, which conducted the Illinois Study. He is best known as the lead author of the original Colorado study, *The Impact of School Library Media Centers on Academic Achievement* (1993) and *How School Librarians Help Kids Achieve Standards: The Second Colorado Study* (2000) as well as successor studies in several states.
